- 1. New St Andrew Street Car Park Bridge Pedestrian, cyclist, and vehicle access bridge
- 2. New central bridge Pedestrian and cyclist bridge
- 3. Existing motte bridge To be removed
- 4. Existing vehicle bridge To be removed
- 5. Ashley Webb Shelter enhancement Renovated with new paving surrounding planting and design changes to deter anti-social behaviour
- 6. Icehouse enhancement Made safe and visible, with occasional access and new interpretation
- 7. Curtain wall enhancement Repairs and interpretation on historic structure and function
- 8. Motte enhancement Retained as a non-accessible feature, enhanced with fencing, planting, and interpretation
- 9. Heritage gravel path Paths widened where needed and resurfaced with resin-bonded gravel overlay
- 10. Heavy use areas upgrade Existing surface improved and overlain with asphalt
- 11. New path and seating Resin bound gravel paths with seating to rivers edge and around Ashley Webb Shelter
- 12. Improved pedestrian entrance Linking with Hertford town centre and BEAM
- 13. Existing play area Removed and replaced with orchard tree species, seating area and events space
- 14. New play area Range of play facilities for all ages and abilities, including swings, climbing, interactive crane, musical & inclusive features
- 15. Castle lawn Retained heritage and events lawn with new seating around the edge

- 16. North of island Open space for informal use and community events
- 17. Ashley Webb lawn To support flexible community use
- 18. Relocated car park 21 bays including 4 EV charging points
- 19. Gatehouse frontage Car park moved to improve heritage setting
- 20. New drinking water fountain
- 21. New fingerpost signage Directional signage within site and to town
- 22. Store Area New bin store, compost bays and storage unit
- 23. New planting History-inspired, with interpretation
- 24. Localised interplanting To existing planting beds with interpretation 25. Wildflower planting Around play area for biodiversity and softening
- 26. New woodland Miyawaki method
- 27. Woodland Edge Openings Opening views/access to back channel
- 28. Possible fish pass Funding dependant item TBC
- 29. Marginal planting To support habitat and bank stability
- 30. Riverbank restoration Structural reinforcement to prevent erosion
- 31. Cycle parking Black sheffield cycle parking stands to match existing
