## **Hertford Castle** Greenspace Renewal



- 1. New St Andrew Street Car Park Bridge New pedestrian, cyclist and vehicle access bridge improving connections to the town.
- 2. New central bridge New pedestrian and cyclist bridge enabling a new route through the greenspace.
- 3. Existing motte bridge Removal of the existing bridge to protect the Scheduled Monument and reinstate historic character.
- 4. Existing vehicle bridge Removal of the existing vehicular bridge to improve heritage setting and riverside views.
- 5. Ashley Webb Shelter enhancement Renovation of the existing shelter with new paving, planting and measures to deter anti-social behaviour.
- 6. Icehouse enhancement Icehouse to be made safe, more visible, and accessible for occasional supervised visits, with new interpretation.
- 7. Curtain wall enhancement Conservation-led masonry repairs and new interpretation explaining historic structure and function. 8. Motte enhancement - Motte retained as a non-accessible heritage feature, protected with sensitive fencing, planting and interpretation.
- 9. Heritage gravel path Existing paths widened where required and resurfaced with a resin-bonded gravel overlay.
- 10. Heavy use areas upgrade High-traffic areas resurfaced with asphalt to improve durability and accessibility.
- 11. New path and seating Resin-bound gravel paths with new riverside seating and additional seating around the Ashley Webb Shelter.
- 12. Improved pedestrian entrance Enhanced gateway linking the Castle grounds more clearly with Hertford town centre and BEAM.
- 13. Existing play area Removal of existing play equipment and replacement with orchard tree species, seating and flexible events space.
- 14. New play area New inclusive play space with equipment for all ages and abilities, including swings, climbing features and musical elements.
- 15. Castle lawn Retained as the primary heritage and events lawn, with new seating along its edges.

- 16. North of island Open space for informal use and community events.
- 17. Lawn spaces New and improved to support flexible community use. 18. Relocated car park - 21 bays including 4 EV charging points.
- 19. Gatehouse frontage Car park moved to improve heritage setting.
- 20. New drinking water fountain Installation of a public water fountain. 21. New fingerpost signage - Directional signage within site and to town.
- 22. Store Area New bin store, compost bays and storage unit.
- 23. New planting History-inspired, with interpretation.
- 24. Localised interplanting To existing planting beds with interpretation.
- 25. Wildflower planting Around play area for biodiversity and softening.
- 26. New woodland Compact native woodland using Miyawaki method.
- 27. Woodland edge openings Opening views/access to back channel.
- 28. Rain garden planting To enhance biodiversity and interest.
- 29. Marginal planting To support habitat and bank stability.
- 30. Riverbank restoration Structural reinforcement to prevent erosion.
- 31. Cycle parking Sheffield cycle parking stands to match existing.
